1. **PREPARING FOR THE NORTH/NORTHERN EXPERIENCE**-A preview of all the items you should have when heading up to the wild blue yonder, including clothing, food and safety tips; plus we explain the various options for the angler and just how much you can rough it, or have everything taken care of for you. **AIRDATE: JUNE 3RD**
2. **WALLEYE BY THE BOATFUL**-Saskatchewan's most popular sportfish the walleye is delicious and extremely plentiful in the North. Watch as we catch fish after fish with some nice chunky ones to boot. **AIRDATE: JUNE 10TH**
3. **SAILFISH OF THE NORTH**-Only available in clean, cold pristine streams in the North and select Mountain regions, the Arctic Grayling is a spectacular fighter on light tackle and its colours are out of this world. **AIRDATE: JUNE 17TH**
4. **CONSERVATION**-Why is the North such a cherished angler's paradise? Mostly it's intact, without human activities altering the Environment. But when human activity collides with the fragile Northern Wilderness, it's far more sensitive and takes longer to recover than more southern climes. We explore the North's fragility and also talk about the importance of its protection. **AIRDATE: JUNE 24TH**
5. **THE NORTHERN NORTHERN PIKE**-Available all over Saskatchewan, there's something special about fishing for the northern in the north. The numbers and average size of these beasts is something to marvel. **AIRDATE: JUNE 30<sup>TH</sup>** (WILL AIR ON A WEDNESDAY AS THURS OF THIS WEEK IS CANADA DAY)
6. **LAKE TROUT**-Saskatchewan's only native trout, we show you one of the big reasons why you need to travel to the far north with it's crystal clear waters to catch trout that can weigh anywhere from 10-50 pounds. **AIRDATE: JULY 8TH**
7. **THE NORTHERN SHORELUNCH**-We go into the bush with our freshly caught walleye or pike, cut some wood and fry up our fish for a true northern shorelunch. **AIRDATE: JULY 15TH**
